

## **Information About the Department of Education's January 2024 Announcement Regarding FAFSA Delays**

On Tuesday January 30, 2024, the U.S. Department of Education (ED) announced that colleges and universities would not receive 2024-25 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) data until at least early March. We understand that this announcement may cause students and families to worry about when and how they will receive their financial aid information. Below is important information regarding this announcement.

### **Fall 2024 Admitted Undergraduate First-Year and Transfer Students**

Unfortunately, since we need the FAFSA data to accurately package federal and institutional financial aid, this does mean we will experience delays in creating and sending out our comprehensive financial aid offers. Rest assured that we are doing everything in our power to be ready to compile and release financial aid offers as soon as we receive the 2024-25 FAFSA data from ED and are able to do so.

### **Currently Enrolled Undergraduate Students**

The 2024-25 FAFSA renewal timeline remains unchanged at this point. If you will be a returning student for 2024-25 we encourage you to submit your [2024-25 FAFSA](#) and [2024-25 TAP application](#) (NY residents only) by our recommended filing date of April 30. We will begin sending financial aid notifications through the MySJNY student portal sometime in June.
